

EVENT COOPERATION AGREEMENT

This Event Cooperation Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between:

SpicyDate Ltd, a company incorporated under the laws of England and Wales ("SpicyDate")

and

_____ ("Partner")

SpicyDate and Partner may be referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

1. PURPOSE

The Parties wish to cooperate in connection with one or more social, recreational, educational, wellness, sports, networking, travel, or other Events promoted through the SpicyDate Platform.

2. EVENT DETAILS

The Parties may agree to additional Events in writing, including by email.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF SPICYDATE

SpicyDate may:

- Promote the Event;
- Market the Event through its Platform and marketing channels;
- Facilitate registrations, bookings, ticket sales, or attendee management;
- Provide visibility and exposure for the Event;
- Communicate with users regarding Event participation;
- Collect feedback and reviews.

SpicyDate acts solely as a technology, marketing, and promotional platform.

SpicyDate does not organize, supervise, manage, operate, inspect, control, certify, or conduct the Event.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTNER

Partner shall be solely responsible for:

- Organizing and operating the Event;
- Event execution and management;
- Event safety and supervision;
- Staff, instructors, guides, hosts, employees, and contractors;
- Equipment, facilities, and venues;
- Transportation and accommodation arrangements (if applicable);
- Required licenses, permits, approvals, and certifications;
- Compliance with applicable laws and regulations;
- Participant management during the Event;
- Customer service relating to the Event.

Partner acknowledges that it is the sole organizer and operator of the Event.

5. COMMERCIAL TERMS

The Parties may agree upon one or more of the following compensation models:

- Fixed event fee;
- Revenue sharing;
- Commission per attendee;
- Marketing fee;
- Sponsorship fee;
- Other agreed compensation.

The Parties may document Event-specific commercial terms, pricing, revenue-sharing arrangements, commissions, discounts, promotional benefits, complimentary tickets, sponsorship benefits, giveaways, prizes, or other compensation in a separate written schedule, email, invoice, proposal, or other written communication.

Commercial terms for each Event shall be documented separately in writing, including email communications.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, each Party shall be responsible for its own costs and expenses incurred in connection with the Event.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, any amounts payable between the Parties shall be paid within fourteen (14) days following the applicable Event.

SpicyDate may collect payments from Event participants on behalf of the Partner where agreed by the Parties.

Any applicable payouts, commissions, fees, refunds, and payment procedures shall be documented in Schedule A.

6. MARKETING RIGHTS

Partner grants SpicyDate a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to use Partner's business name, Event name, logos, trademarks, photographs, videos, descriptions, promotional materials, and related content for purposes of promoting the Event, the Platform, and future marketing activities.

7. CANCELLATIONS

Partner shall promptly notify SpicyDate of any cancellation, postponement, material change, safety issue, venue issue, staffing issue, or operational issue affecting the Event.

Refund responsibilities shall be determined according to the Parties' commercial arrangements, applicable laws, and Platform policies.

8. LIABILITY

Partner acknowledges that it is solely responsible for:

- Event operations;
- Event safety;
- Participant safety;
- Staff conduct;
- Compliance obligations;
- Service delivery.

SpicyDate shall not be responsible for any injury, illness, death, property damage, accident, loss, dispute, misconduct, negligence, regulatory issue, or claim arising from the Event.

9. INSURANCE

Partner shall maintain any insurance coverage required by applicable law or reasonably appropriate for the Event and its activities.

SpicyDate does not provide insurance coverage for Partner activities unless expressly agreed in writing.

10. INDEMNIFICATION

Partner agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless SpicyDate, its affiliates, directors, officers, employees, contractors, and representatives from and against any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, fines, penalties, costs, expenses, or legal fees arising from:

- The Event;
- Partner activities;
- Partner personnel;
- Partner services;
- Partner facilities;
- Participant claims;
- Violations of law;
- Breach of this Agreement.

11. GOOD FAITH COOPERATION

Partner acknowledges that Event participants introduced through SpicyDate may continue interacting with Partner independently after the Event.

Nothing in this Agreement restricts lawful business relationships between Partner and Event participants.

The Parties agree to act in good faith and not intentionally interfere with each other's business relationships arising directly from the Event.

12. PARTNER TERMS

The Partner Terms and Conditions are incorporated into this Agreement by reference and form part of this Agreement.

In the event of conflict between this Agreement and the Partner Terms, this Agreement shall govern solely with respect to the specific Event covered by this Agreement.

Each Party shall comply with applicable data protection and privacy laws when handling participant information received in connection with the Event.

13. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

Nothing in this Agreement creates any:

- Partnership;
- Joint venture;
- Agency relationship;
- Employment relationship;
- Franchise relationship;
- Fiduciary relationship.

Each Party acts as an independent contractor and independent business entity.

14. EVENT MEDIA

Partner acknowledges that photographs, videos, and promotional content may be created during the Event.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, each Party may use Event-related media for reasonable marketing and promotional purposes.

15. CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties agree to keep confidential any non-public business, commercial, pricing, marketing, operational, customer, or strategic information exchanged in connection with the Event unless disclosure is required by law.

This obligation shall survive termination of this Agreement.

16. TERM AND TERMINATION

Either Party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice.

Termination shall not affect obligations arising before termination, including payment obligations, indemnification obligations, confidentiality obligations, or liability provisions.

Either Party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice, provided that termination shall not affect any Event already scheduled unless otherwise agreed by the Parties.

17. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be liable for delays or failures caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including natural disasters, severe weather, government actions, labor disputes, public health emergencies, utility failures, internet failures, acts of war, terrorism, or similar force majeure events.

18. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

19. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties regarding the Event and supersedes all prior discussions, negotiations, and understandings relating to the Event.

20. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES

Electronic signatures, scanned signatures, and electronically exchanged copies shall be deemed original signatures and shall be legally binding.
