

SAFETY POLICY

Effective Date: 04 June 2026

1. INTRODUCTION

At SpicyDate, user safety is a priority.

SpicyDate helps people build real-life connections through dating, social experiences, events, communities, travel, and shared activities. While we strive to create a safe environment, no online platform can guarantee the safety, conduct, intentions, identity, or behavior of every user.

This Safety Policy provides recommendations, guidance, and safety information to help users make informed decisions when interacting with others through the Platform.

By using SpicyDate, you acknowledge that all interactions with other users occur at your own risk and that you are responsible for your personal decisions, safety, and conduct.

2. MEETING PEOPLE SAFELY

When meeting another user for the first time:

- Meet in a public place whenever possible;
- Inform a trusted friend or family member of your plans;
- Share your location with someone you trust;
- Arrange your own transportation;
- Trust your instincts if something feels wrong;
- Leave immediately if you feel unsafe;

3. FIRST DATE SAFETY

When attending a date arranged through the Platform:

- Respect personal boundaries and consent;

Never feel obligated to continue a meeting, conversation, relationship, or interaction.

4. EVENT SAFETY

Before attending an Event:

- Review Event details carefully;
- Evaluate the Host's information;
- Consider the location, activity, and associated risks;
- Understand any costs or requirements;
- Confirm that the Event is appropriate for your abilities and experience level.

During an Event:

- Follow applicable laws and venue rules;
- Respect Hosts and Participants;
- Follow safety instructions;
- Exercise reasonable caution;
- Leave any Event that appears unsafe.

SpicyDate does not organize, supervise, inspect, or guarantee Events created by independent Hosts.

Hosts are solely responsible for obtaining any insurance, licenses, permits, certifications, waivers, or approvals required for their Events under applicable law.

5. TRAVEL SAFETY

Some Events may involve travel, accommodation, outdoor activities, destination experiences, or international travel.

Before participating:

- Research the destination;
- Verify travel arrangements independently;
- Obtain appropriate travel insurance where available;
- Carry necessary documentation;
- Understand local laws and customs;
- Maintain emergency contact information.

6. FINANCIAL SAFETY

7. ROMANCE SCAMS AND FRAUD

Be alert for potential scams.

Warning signs may include:

- Requests for money;
- Inconsistent personal information;
- Refusal to meet in person;
- Requests to move conversations off-platform immediately;
- Claims of emergencies requiring financial assistance;
- Pressure to send Gifts or support;
- Requests for banking information or passwords.
- Requests for cryptocurrency transfers or investment opportunities;

Report suspicious activity immediately.

8. GIFTS, SUPPORT, AND CROWDFUNDING SAFETY

Gifts, support payments, and crowdfunding contributions are voluntary.

Before contributing:

- Evaluate the recipient independently;
- Understand that outcomes are not guaranteed;
- Review information carefully;
- Avoid making decisions under pressure.

Sending financial support does not create any entitlement to:

- Communication;
- Meetings;
- Relationships;
- Content;
- Attention;
- Personal access;
- Any guaranteed outcome.

Gifts, support payments, and crowdfunding contributions should never be considered investments and do not create ownership rights, repayment obligations, or guaranteed returns.

9. PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Exercise caution when sharing personal information.

Avoid sharing:

- Financial account information;
- Passwords;
- Government identification numbers;
- Sensitive personal records;
- Home addresses;
- Employment information that could create security risks.
- Copies of passports, driver's licenses, or identity documents;

Users are responsible for the information they choose to disclose.
